Check Local Guidelines

Remind residents to check local recycling guidelines for specific items that may have special disposal requirements such as vapes or chemicals

Separate Different Materials

Check for hidden batteries in rechargeable items and make sure these are disposed of correctly.



Remove Lids from Bottles and Jars

Instruct to remove plastic lids and metal caps before recycling.

Rinse Containers Before Recycling

Emphasise the importance of rinsing food and drink containers to prevent contamination.

Flatten Cardboard Boxes

Encourage residents to flatten cardboard to save space in recycling bins. Stack all plastic pots tubs and trays
